1. **Title:** “Mentoring Students from Backward Region”

2. **Objective of the Practice:**

The College has been planned to uplift the backward students through "**Mentor-Mentee Program**". The concept of Mentor-Mentee program was originated from the UGC Guidelines on student upliftment through learning by doing. The practice of the program came into reality by providing tutorial classes in the Time Table each year. Students with more efficiency, mediocre and back-lagging are benefited with these tutorial classes. Teachers involved themselves both online and offline to clear the doubts of the students.

Later from the lockdown period due to COVID, these classes turned into Mentor-Mentee Programs. Mentee-students freely trained themselves by the Mentor-teachers. They love the process, cultivate and practice to empower themselves in the higher education.

3. **The Context:**

The steady urge made by the people of Kashipur for the establishment of a College was fulfilled and the cherished Mahavidyalaya came into being on **26th September 2000**. The opening of the College at Kashipur at once offered invaluable service in regard to the spread of educational opportunity for a large number of prospective students of a comparatively backward district. Their opportunities constitute our aims. The opportunities are:

- i) To provide the students of Kashipur and adjacent area with the opportunity to enhance their educational qualification through receiving higher education and to enable them to build their capacity necessary for being effectively and gainfully employed;
- ii) To bring the local people living around in touch with various educational and social welfare services undertaken by the College through NSS or other extension activities; and
- iii) To humbly attempt to create an atmosphere of learning and awakening through the gradual spread of education and academic culture.

The College has always been receiving generous help and cooperation from the people associated with it and also from the people and well-wishers at large as well as eminent personalities of the locality. We hope and believe that this cooperation will go on increasing. To cope up with the situation, the college authority tried to help the students by this Mentor-Mentee Program which help the students to speak out their thinking, exchange their ideas and to materialize their dreams.

4. The Practice:

There are two types of mentoring going on in the college by the departments: (a) Continuous evaluation, and (b) Mentor-Mentee Program.

Continuous evaluation starts from the beginning of a session with each chapter completion and a class test has been arranged to judge the progress of the students. After completion of at least three-to-four chapter and/or completion of more than 60 percent of syllabus, a Mentor-Mentee Program has been organized by the department. During the process, Mentor-teachers divided the students into groups as per number of teachers for the department. Then by choosing a topic for each of the Mentee-student, they prepared them. After the preparation, students were asked for a physical or online presentation of their selective topics. Mentors and other teacher present in the program, guide them to make them strong in their respective filed of study.

5. Evidence of Success:

Till date eleven such Mentor-Mentee Programs have been organized by the various department of the college. Economics, Geography, Bengali, History, Sociology and Science arranged the most of it.

(a) After these programs, students perform better in their examinations. Results improved personally and for the department also.

(b) Result of pre-program and post-program of Mentor-Mentee which shows a positive impact of the program are as follows:

(c) Classes have been more attractive after the successful completion of such programs. Students are eagerly waiting for the next session of Mentor-Mentee Program as they can learn from their seniors too by the program.

6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required:

(a) Many departments were unaware of the program, so they had started late for their students.

(b) A few department are not continuing with this program as students are not ready to prepare and presentation the same. IQAC still working on it to convince the department to continue with the program.

(c) For online presentation, more than 50% of students are not able to prepare power point presentation, though they are ready to present verbally of their article.

(d) Writing skill are not improving for some subjects. Students are more fluent with verbal presentation, but not properly able to written their views in the examination papers.

7. Notes (Optional):

As per UGC guidelines, the college has been able to convinced each of the eighteen department for continuous evaluation and at least one Mentor-Mentee Program per session. These two programs are extra of their regular activities of class taken (Theory, Practical and Seminar mode), internal assessment and final semester examination.

Most of the students are popularized with the activities and cooperating throughout the session. A few students are still surviving with the old CBCS and NEP structure of their course of study. IQAC of the college is working on it to streamlining all the students with their academic endeavour.
